- ☐ *Moisturizing Cream
- ☐ *Toothbrush(es)
- ☐ *Floss
- ☐ *Toothpaste
- ☐ *Antiperspirant
- ☐ *Eye Drops
- ☐ *Pre-moistened Towelettes
- ☐ *Sealable Plastic Bags

**If at all possible, these items should be packed and ready to go throughout the fire season*

- ☐ *Luggage/Go Bag
- ☐ *Umbrellas
- ☐ *Wooden matches
- ☐ *N95 Face masks (for smoke)
- ☐ *Ear plugs (evacuation centers can be noisy)
- ☐ Books & Games
- ☐ Personal electronics & long extension cord(s)
- ☐ Backpacks
- ☐ Club soda to rinse out stains

FOOD & FOOD ITEMS

- ☐ *Water (1 GAL/person & pet X 3 days)
- ☐ *Bottled water
- ☐ *Energy bars
- ☐ *Water purifier
- ☐ *Can opener
- ☐ *Plastic cups
- ☐ *Plastic cutlery
- ☐ *Paper plates and napkins
- ☐ *Aluminum foil/plastic food wrap
- ☐ Fruits & vegetables
- ☐ Snacks

Priceless

- ☐ Photo Albums
- ☐ Heirlooms
- ☐ Precious artwork
- ☐ Jewelry
- ☐ Other

If Time Permits, Do Before Departing

- ☐ Place white towel/sheet at front door/gate (to signify that house has been evacuated)
- ☐ Turn off heater/air conditioner(s)
- ☐ If you have a "Pet(s) Inside" notice, and you are evacuating all of your pets, remove the notice.
- ☐ Unlock Gates
- ☐ Unlock Doors
- ☐ Close all exterior doors and windows & remove nearby interior flammables (curtains/drapes)
- ☐ Close interior doors
- ☐ Remove portable propane tanks, firewood & other flammables 30+ feet away from buildings and other structures' perimeters
- ☐ Notify close friends and relatives of your plans
- ☐ Leave keys in vehicles left behind (so that they can be moved by firefighters)
- ☐ Attach hoses & nozzles to exterior water faucets
- ☐ Leave 1 or more lights on inside and outside
- ☐ Assure that neighbors are aware
- ☐ Assist neighbors in need

- ☐ If large animals cannot be transported, mark cell phone number on animal(s) and set them free
- ☐ If you need assistance, call YCSO **As Soon As Possible**.

What to do in advance

- ☐ If you have functional needs and may need assistance evacuating, fill in and submit the County's [Function Needs Evacuation Form](#)
- ☐ Sign up and pay attention to alertYAVAPAI, the County's Emergency Alert System - <https://member.everbridge.net/337829242601768/new>
- ☐ Know your evacuation zone, available at <https://protect.genasys.com>
- ☐ Assure that everyone in the family knows your evacuation destination. Have at least one backup destination
- ☐ In case the family is separated, identify a reunion location. **Don't rely on cell phone service.**
- ☐ Have all packing material you will need
- ☐ Have travel crates for each small animal (dog size and below)
- ☐ Have on-hand trailer(s) and vehicle(s) needed to move large animals or know how they will be moved and by whom during an emergency. **Arrange movement at the first sign of danger.**
- ☐ Know where large animals and pets can be dropped off
- ☐ **Firewise your property!**
